AG&P was contracted to undertake the fabrication of steel structures, mechanical equipment, piping and other construction and installation works for the new motor gasoline pipeline for PSPC's North Mindanao Import Facility (NMIF) Project in Cagayan de Oro, Philippines.

NMIF is an expansion of Shell's existing Cagayan De Oro oil depot and has 90-million-liter capacity to receive medium-range (MR) vessels from abroad. In 2016, it successfully received its first MR vessel carrying approximately 25 million liters of automotive diesel oil to signal its completion and later, commenced its operations.

AG&P provided a dedicated team of experienced professionals and craftsmen including riggers, pipefitters, welders, scaffolders, painters, electricians and foremen to take responsibility for functions at the project site, bridging the demand for scarce onsite labor, which significantly reduced workforce costs and timelines.

The AG&P project team successfully completed its scope in December 2016, achieving 762,140 man-hours without Lost-Time Incident (LTI). AG&P continues to hold the world's best construction safety record for safe man-hours, with only one minor LTI over the last decade.
